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1. Location :

Diagonally across from the entrance of the Red Barrikade Plant in Stalingrad (44°25'E/48°45'N), west of the railroad line.

2. Plant installations :

The destroyed plant, 225 x 80 meters, was reconditioned after the war when essential enlargements of the installation were planned. Parts of the plant were in operation in August 1949. The switching station was a solidly constructed stone building, 40 x 9 meters. The ground floor housed the switching room and an office and the second floor the administration offices. Foundations for a transformer repair shop were made in the Summer of 1949. The plant had a railroad connection.

3. Work force :

Forty PWs and forty Soviets per shift.

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4. Switching plates indicated that the power arrived in phases of 11,000 and 6,600 Volts, which was converted (transformed) to 220 Volt and, for the Red Barrikade Plant, to 330 Volt.

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
