Diagonally across from the entrance of the Red Barrikade Plant in Stalingrad (44025'E/48045'H), west of the railroad line.

Flant installations :

The destroyed plant, 225 x 30 meters, was reconditioned after the war when essential enlargements of the installation were planned. Parts of the plant were in operation in August 1949. The switching station was a solidly constructed stone building, 40 x 9 meters. The ground floor housed the switching room and an office and the second floor the administration offices. Foundations for a transformer repair shop were made in the Summer or 1949. The plant had a railroad connection.

Forty PWs and forty Soviets per shift.
