On 11 February 1952, Cottbus airfield was occupied by 38 Pe-2s, 3 Pe-3s with twin cabins, 3 jet bombers, and 3 twin-engine planes with nose wheels. On 13 February, 37 to 40 Pe-2s, 3 Pe-2s with two cabins, 3 twin-engine planes with nose wheels, and 3 jet bombers were observed at the field. There was flying by three planes with nose wheels and the jet bomber [Redacted]

* [Redacted] Comment. The report confirms previous information according to which the bomber regiment with about 40 Pe-2s is apparently being equipped with type-27 planes. [Redacted] the three jet bombers at the field [Redacted] The aircraft were probably turned over to the regiment by the Northern Bmr Div for training purposes.
