Comment: Since production of diesel fuel in the DDR is presently insufficient to meet the export quotas to the USSR and Satellites and the needs of the DDR domestic economy, no diesel is to be exported before April 1952 to West Germany or West Europe; the DDR is attempting to substitute Kogasin I and II for domestic consumption of diesel fuel.)
