The post of Director of the Vladimir Bakaric Industrial Enterprise, a diesel engine factory in Samchor, Croatia, became vacant during the spring of 1951, when the then Director, Colonel Zlatko Kerekovic, was transferred to an unspecified position. Bozo Cukrilovic is still serving as Commercial Director of the Enterprise.
2. The Vladimir Bakaric Enterprise, which is under the direct control and jurisdiction of the General Directorate of National Industrial Production, is being constructed by the Tempo Military Construction Enterprise of Zagreb, under the supervision of Major Ilija Batas. When completed, the Vladimir Bakaric Factory will produce diesel engines for the Yugoslav Navy.
