THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

1. One of the largest Russian ammunition depots in Hungary is located 2 km. from Pátka (Z 11).
2. Between 7-19 December 1951 the railroad traffic supplying this depot has increased from 4-5 cars per day to 20-23 cars per day. The ammunition was handled only by Russian soldiers.
3. For the most part the supplies destined for this depot consisted of artillery shells and air-force bombs; incoming small-arms ammunition was negligible in quantity.
4. According to unconfirmed rumors the depot serves the artillery units stationed at the ranges in the vicinity of Hajmáskér (D 79).
