- For the most part the supplies destined for this depot consisted of artillery shells and air-force bombs; incoming small-arms ammunition was negligible in quantity.
- 4. According to unconfirmed rumors the depot serves the artillery units stationed at the ranges in the vicinity of Hajmäsker (D 79).
