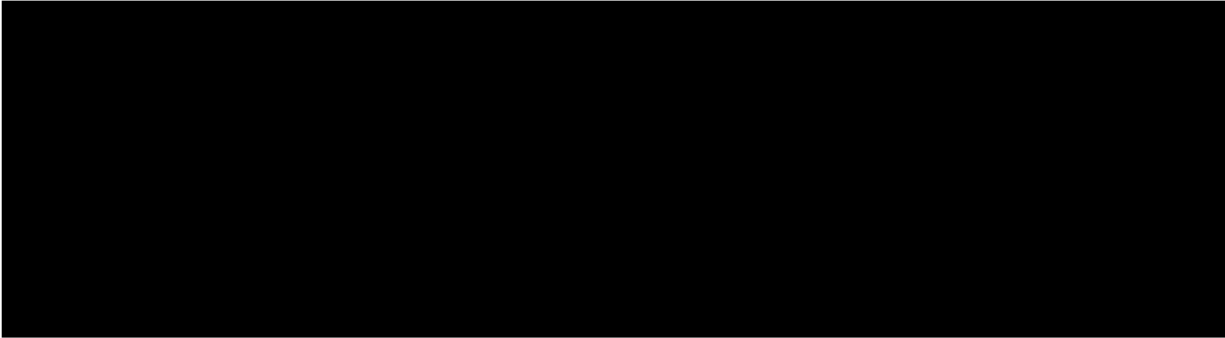

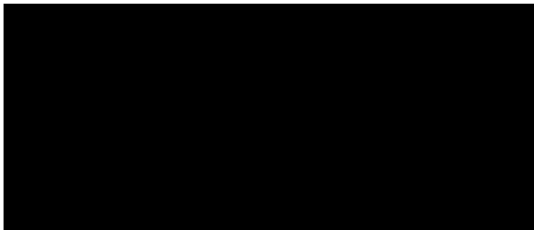
- 1. No important observations were made concerning the village of Goepfritz. According to local information, soldiers (mostly very young) are under curfew. They come for three-weeks' training, reportedly firing practice.
- 2. At the railroad station 10 closed and 10 open freight cars (2-axled) were parked near the loading ramp. The entraining personnel consisted of one major, one captain and 20 men (all with black-red service color and tank insignia). On and next to the loading ramp tank tracks were clearly visible. Four additional closed freight cars, with ovens, were parked at the railroad
