1. The KBW training center, [redacted], at Legnica (Liegnitz-052/B82) [redacted] had 800 soldiers and two companies of 130 cadets each. The graduates of the two year course were commissioned as warrant officers or as second lieutenants. The commandant of the school was Col. Szyszko, who was succeeded by a Russian, Frilolov.

2. The commander of the KBW is Major General Hybner.

3. Information about various KBW units is as follows:

a. 1st KBW Brigade: Consists of four battalions each with a strength of 630. The 1st Battalion is motorized and includes a liaison company, a heavy weapons company and a special light machine gun platoon. This battalion is commanded by Capt. Kosztylo who came to Poland with the Soviet Army. [redacted] the 3rd battalion was commanded by a Major Polkowski, a former partisan in the Communist sponsored Armja Ludowa and in the Peasant Bataljony Chlopskie in the Lublin area where he operated under the code name "Sosna". Since completing the six weeks officers' candidate course at Deblin, Polkowski advanced rapidly and appears to have a strong position in the Communist party.

b. 2nd KBW Brigade: Stationed at Bialystok (S54/G49) with headquarters on Ulica Wiejska, commanded by Major Danielewicz who came to Poland with the Polish First Army from the Soviet Union.

c. 3rd KBW Brigade: Stationed at Lublin with headquarters on former Ulica 3go Maja. The brigade executive officer is Capt. Rysnik,

a Pole from the regions east of the Bug River now in Soviet possession. Rysnik came to Poland with the Polish First Army from the Soviet Union.

- h. 8th KBW Brigade: Stationed at Zielona Gora (Gruenberg-052/B39).
- i. 12th KBW Brigade: Stationed at Olsztyn (Allenstein-R54/E66).
