* Comment. On the 46 days of the period under review, a total of 426 cars which were shunted during eight hours of observation per day. The actual number of cars shunted would be approximately 1,250 cars or a daily average of 27 cars, as compared with the period from December 1951 to February 1952, the supply traffic increased from 19 to 27 cars.
