Jet planes, first believed to be improved models of the MIG-15 and later identified as Lavochkins, were observed at Koethen between 20 and 26 November 1951. They differed from the standard Mig-I3 In that their air intake was much wider and their sound different. The speed of the plane seemed to be 100 to 150 km per hours faster than that of the jet types previously observed.
