Equipment unloaded at the Wuenstorf (L 53/2 91) railroad station during the period from 4 through 13 May 1952 included: 25 new trucks, on 4 May; 55 new trucks, on 5 May; 4 searchlights with a diameter of about 1 meter each, on 6 May; 50 new trucks, on 8 May; 60 new trucks \_\_\_\_\_ on 13 May; and 8 x 85-mm AT guns, also on 13 May. (1)

On 16 May, \_\_\_\_\_ three Soviet women \_\_\_\_\_ their tailor to finish their dresses sooner than originally arranged because their units would move to Ruegen Island which they referred to as "the big land in the sea". 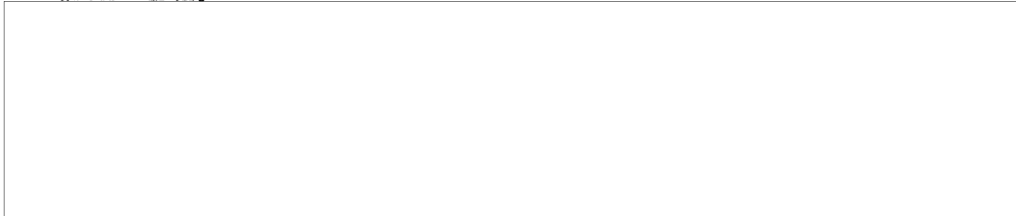

Comments.

- (1) [redacted] 90 to 100 new trucks were unloaded on [redacted] If the information contained in the present report is correct, this would mean that a maximum of 300 trucks were unloaded at Wuensdorf during the period from 1 to 13 May.
- (2) These Soviet women possibly belong to the 4th AT Arty Brig (US) of the IV Arty Corps from Jueterbog. This brigade moved to Ruegen Island on 8 May.
- (3) No information has been received indicating that troop units left the Lutz Kaserne. There is a possibility that this information refers to component units of the 62d AAA Div (US), which was observed in Mustraw after March.
