The following military shipments were seen at the Oranienburg (N 53/Z 67) freight station:

At 12:40 p.m. on 21 May 1952: One coach occupied by troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets and 50 flatcars carrying 50 new [redacted] trucks from Sassnitz on Ruegen Island to Doeberitz. 50X1-HUM

At 8:10 a.m. on 24 May: 16 boxcars including 10 occupied by soldiers wearing red-bordered black epaulets, 16 flatcars carrying 8 jeeps and 10 trucks [redacted] from Altes Lager in Jueterbog to Neustrelitz. 50X1-HUM

At 9:10 p.m. on 27 May: 18 boxcars including 11 occupied by troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets, 29 flatcars carrying 1 field kitchen and 29 trucks [redacted] from Neustrelitz to Jueterbog. \*\* 50X1-HUM

Comment. The train carried an engineer unit of the Second Gds Mecz Army.
