1. On 29 April 1952, [redacted] observed a shipment of 3 flatcars, each carrying three horse-drawn vehicles, and 1 boxcar loaded with blue fatigue uniforms. [redacted]

2. On 29 April, a train, carrying mostly trucks, was dispatched from Altenburg (N 51/K 27) and left toward Leipzig (N 52/E 21). The majority of the trucks were loaded with boxes which came from the two barracks installations east and west of Leipzigerstrasse. [redacted]

units stationed in Altenburg are believed to include:
In the Artillerie Kaserne west of Leipzigerstrasse. The 43d Cds Army Arty Brig of the Eighth Cds Army, which moved to Altengrabow by 4 to 6 rail shipments in late April 1952. [redacted] 50X1-HUM
In the Infanterie Kaserne east of Leipzigerstrasse. The 38th (?) Army AT Arty Brig of the Eighth Cds Army, which, according to another source, was still there on 28 April 1952. [redacted] The motor vehicles loaded on 50X1-HUM April 1952 which were mentioned in paragraph 2 of the present report probably belong to the above 38th (?) Army AT Brig, and possibly are the beginning of a movement of the brigade.
