- 3 --The present report confirms that offices of the Chief of the Rear Services of the GOFG left the Adolf Hitler Maserne, probably for Wuensdorf. The motor vehicles observed (3) The motor vehicles observed 25X1 belong to these offices. (4)The notor vehicles observed indicate that the Wildpark West Kaserne was occupied by units of the 56th Lotor Trans Regt of the GOFG. Further information is needed to determine whether the regiment will stay there only as long as the 25X1 reshuffling of units in the Potsdam-Wuensdorf-Jueterbog area is underway or whether it will be permanently stationed there. 25X(5) the Garde du Corps Kaserne was completely vacated on 28 May and would be reoccupied by Volkspolizei. The information contained in the present report indicates that trucks of the GOFF were observed with the 25X1 reoccupying troops. The present report confirms the transfer to the area of Justerbog of Hq units of the Third Gds Mecz Army previously stationed in Wuensdorf.
