THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

1. On 20 April 1952 about 80 jet planes and approximately ten bi-motored planes were stationed at Riga/Spilve airfield. Few military planes were observed in the air, and passenger traffic appeared to be normal.
2. Three antiaircraft batteries, each consisting of three 10.5 cm. guns, are located at Daugavgriva, Latvian SSR. Radar equipment and searchlights are also installed at Daugavgriva. The antiaircraft guns can be seen from the mouth of the Daugava River.
