1. On 7 May, Major General K'o-li-ssu-chi (0344/4409/2448/1015), commander of the Soviet Far East Fleet, arrived in Dairen aboard the destroyer S.S. CAUCACUS, with an entourage including 10 naval officers. 10 Shun-ch'u, chief of staff of the Chinese Communist Navy and Lieutenant General T'o-le, Tsingtao representative of the Soviet Navy, came to Dairen to meet K'o-li-ssu-chi and accompany the group on an inspection trip of naval installations at Dairen, Port Arthur and Hulutao.
2. Soviet naval strength in the Dairen-Port Arthur area has been steadily increasing. About 30 naval vessels of various types are stationed in the two harbors.
