Comment. The outgoing shipments of Unit [redacted] are of special interest.

The ordnance depot at Fuerstenwalde, [redacted] supplies the German Volkspolizei. Twenty-two of the 29 shipments were listed in previous reports. [redacted]

The assumption that the boxcars carried ammunition may be correct as all artillery ammunition bound for Unit Fuerstenwalde, was reported to have crossed the border at Frankfurt/Oder.

The volume of 129 cars unloaded in 12 days is considered normal. The volume of 687 cars loaded during the period of observation is unusually high. This is due to the heavy supply of arms delivered to the Volkspolizei and ammunition from the Pfaffendorf ammunition depot to Gransee. It is undetermined whether the ammunition was bound for Soviet units at the Templin troop training grounds or for the Volkspolizei. [redacted] belongs to the 36th Pan Regt of the GDR in Magdeburg. [redacted] presumably belongs to a distribution point for tractors in Fuerstenwalde. [redacted] presumably belongs to one of the two tank battalions of the two mechanized regiments of the 7th Gds Mccz Div in Fuerstenwalde.
