REMARKS

1. On 10 June 1952, 13 x 76.2-mm AA guns, 1 x 25-mm AA gun [redacted] were loaded in Kuestrin (O 53/V 66) for Kropelin. *
2. On 11 June, 100 new soldiers carrying suitcases and rucksacks arrived in the Panzer Kaserne in Neubrandenburg (N 54/U 66).
3. Two trains carrying light AA guns and about 500 ET were unloaded at the Eberswalde (N 53/V 08) railroad station on 13 June. The shipping document indicated that the train came from Neubrandenburg and was bound for Unit [redacted] in Eberswalde. *
On 14 June, 21 rocket launchers and about 400 soldiers wearing red-bordered black epaulets were entrained at the Eberswalde railroad station. [redacted]
On 14 June, two trains with trucks, which came from the direction of Frankfurt/Oder and proceeded in the direction of Templin, were routed via the loop in Eberswalde which was used for the first time. On 18 June, a train consisting of 20 boxcars carrying personnel and an undetermined number of flatcars carrying 15 rocket launchers, [redacted] was unloaded in Eberswalde, coming from Templin. [redacted]
4. On 17 June, 15 boxcars with soldiers, 3 boxcars with ammunition and an undetermined number of flatcars, carrying 15 rocket launchers, and 30 trucks, [redacted] were entrained at the Lieberose railroad station. The train departed in the direction of Frankfurt/Oder at 9:30 p.m. 1952.

[redacted] Comment. The train which carried units of the 32d AAA Div (US) was previously reported [redacted] as bound for Wustrow. [redacted]

[redacted] Comment. [redacted] a train carrying medium guns of the unidentified AAA division of the Fourth Gds Recz Army, which probably came from Wustrow, was unloaded in Eberswalde. [redacted] The trains mentioned in the present report may also have come from Wustrow. [redacted] is not known and probably was confused [redacted] which is believed to belong to a regiment of the aforementioned division.
