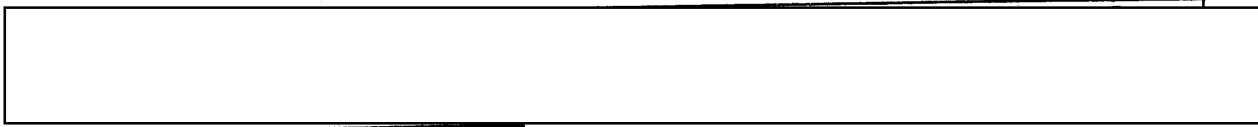

1. The former German paper factory at Skolwin (Odermuende), approximately 10 km. north of Szczecin (Stettin), was stripped of machinery by the Russians in 1945, and ceased production.
2. Since March 1951, the factory has been under reconstruction. It is to be considerably extended; the main building is to be enlarged, and the construction of new warehouses is in progress. Machinery was delivered from the USSR in September and October 1951.
3. The factory, which is to manufacture paper and cellulose, is scheduled to start production in August 1952, and will be the largest works of its kind in Poland.
4. Power will be supplied by a newly built power plant located at a distance of approximately 3 km.
5. The plan for the reconstruction of the factory was drawn up by the State Planning Office of Maritime Construction (Panstwowe Biuro Projektow Budownictwa Morskiego).
