2. [ ] fishing vessels from Klaipeda, Smiltine, and Stariske are allowed to fish only in the Kursiu Ilanka and are not permitted to go into the Baltic Sea.
3. The area northwest and south of Klaipeda which is shaded and numbered "2" on Attachment No. 1 is a prohibited zone. The reason for this is not known.

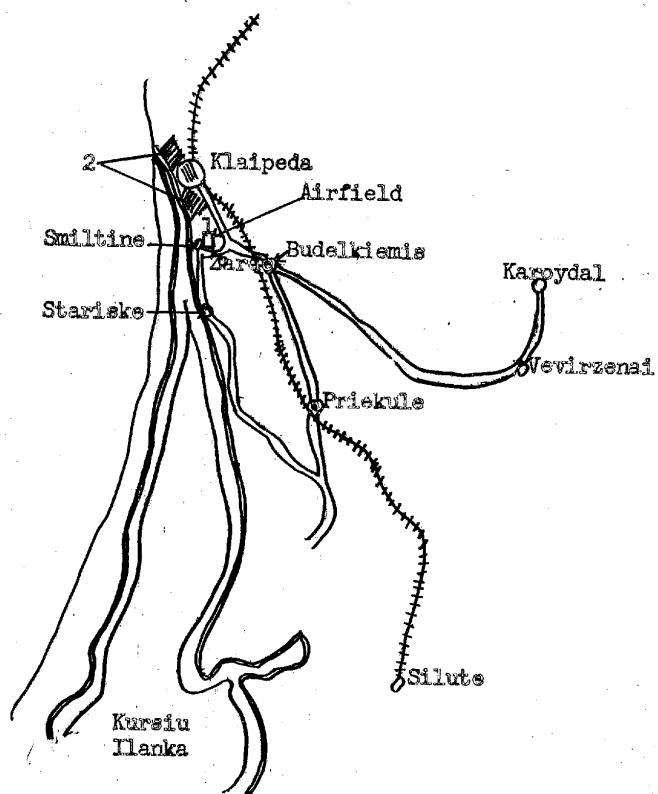

Smiltine Airfield

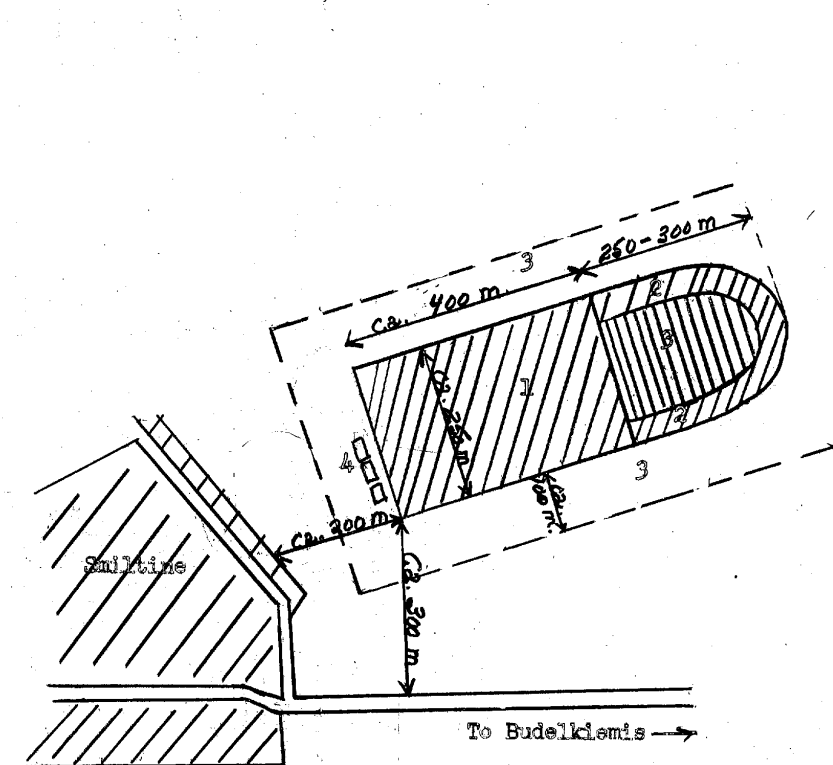

Layout Sketch of Smiltine Airfield



Key to sketch

1. Concrete area of approximately 400 x 250 meters.
2. Cement or concrete runway, shaped like a horseshoe and about 30 meters wide.
3. Firm grass surface.
4. Three wooden huts, each 30 x 10 meters.
