THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

1. Soviet Air Commander Menchikov (fnu) is in charge of the airbase at Ferihegy, 9½ miles southeast of Budapest. He is assisted by 12 Russians, of whom 7 are radio operators.
2. It is expected that by the end of September 1952, the remaining Hungarian personnel at the field, will be replaced by members of the Soviet Air Force.
