1. [redacted] the harbor at Ventspils, Latvian SSR, was crowded with merchant vessels awaiting unloading. One ship waited twelve days to unload, and a second waited six days before she was unloaded.
2. There were only a few Soviet merchant vessels in the harbor, and no Polish merchant ships were observed. The vessels which awaited unloading included [redacted] fishing vessels, and [redacted] merchantmen.
3. Leningrad harbor was also [redacted] full of vessels awaiting dock space.
