1. Troop trains [redacted] of the Greifswald regional railroad headquarters during the period between 11 and 16 June 1952 included: a train from Eberswalde to Frankfurt/Oder, 2 trains from Neubrandenburg to Frankfurt/Oder, 2 trains from Neustrelitz to Kyritz; and, on 17 June a train with [redacted] from Neubrandenburg to Dangarten. (1)

2. The following troop trains [redacted] of the 3d Subdistrict Office of the Berlin railroad district during the period between 20 June and 3 July:

3. [redacted] the Soviet transport control headquarters to the Berlin regional railroad headquarters indicated that the following numbers of cars had to be made available on the following days:
7 July. Twenty flatcars and 10 heavy-duty cars at Brandenburg-Alt railroad station (4);
11 July. Nineteen converted boxcars, 2 boxcars and 3 kitchen cars, transitworthy, at the Neuruppin railroad station.
16 July. 5 converted boxcars and 3 boxcars, transitworthy, as reserve at the

Comments.

- (1) [redacted] confirms two of four trains to Kyritz which had been reported by [redacted]
- (2) The 5 boxcars and 8 flatcars which went to Neubukow probably carried an AAA unit of the Third Gds Weez Army to Gustrów. The destination of the cars which went as far as Seddin is unknown.
- (3) The train [redacted] of the two trains mentioned in paragraph 2 from Rehagen to Altenrabow of the present report was con-
- (4) [redacted] on 2 July entraining practices were performed at the Brandenburg-Alt airfield. [redacted]
- (5) This information is another confirmation for the turn-over of personnel which is believed about to begin. Corresponding information by the same and [redacted] on Jueterbog and Weimar respectively.
