that HUANG K'ao-ch'eng was secretary of the Hunan CCP.  
25X1 [ ] named HUANG as commanding officer of the  
Hunan Military District, as of November 1951.
- 25X1 5. [ ] reported that in March 1952 OU Meng-chueh was  
head of the South China Sub-Bureau in Canton; a member of the Kwangtung  
Government Council; and a leading figure in UFD activities in South China.
- 25X1 6. [ ] Comment. It is rather surprising that one or more of the following  
prominent personalities in the labor world are not officials of the Workers'  
Committee:

- 25X1 7. [ ] Comment. TSO Hung-t'ao has been found guilty of corruption and his  
post temporarily assumed by the Chief, K'UNG Shih-ch'uan.  
25X1 [ ] Comment. There has been no trace of K'UNG or TSO in connection with  
Overseas Chinese Affairs.
- 25X1 8. [ ] Comment. JAO Chang-feng was reported in the Nan Fang Jih Pao on  
1 February 1952 as head of the Secretarial Office of a committee formed by  
the South China Sub-Bureau to allocate buildings and vehicles to official  
bodies in Canton.  
25X1 [ ] More recently named JAO as head of both the United  
Front and Organization Departments of the South China Sub-Bureau, in July 1952.
- 25X1 9. [ ] Comment. PIEN Kuang was reported in June 1951, [ ]  
25X1 [ ] as an official of the Canton municipal government.
- 25X1 10. [ ] Comment. KU Ta-ts'un was reported in 1950 to be the Vice-Governor of 25X1  
Kwangtung. In December 1951 he was reported [ ] to be head  
of the training department of the South China Sub-Bureau. He was reported by  
the Nan Fang Jih Pao on 1 February 1952 as chairman of a special committee to  
take charge of the allocation of buildings and vehicles to official bodies in  
Canton. See comment 8 above.

Central Committee of the CCP, as of 1948.
- 25X1 12. [ ] Comment. According to information available to this office, HSIAO
