 25X1 Lifeboats and work boats for Czechoslovakia were built at VVM Schiffswerft Altwarp (53°44'N/14°16'E). Five lifeboats and four work boats were delivered by the yard on 10 April 1952. They were hauled to Bratislava. The price of a lifeboat was 13,540 rubles or 10,700 eastmarks.

* [REDACTED] Comment. The production plan of the Vereinigung Volkseigener Werften (Union of Nationalized Shipyards) (VVM) provides for the construction of 33 lifeboats and 10 work boats in the Altwarp shipyard in 1952. The order for [REDACTED] The order for the construction was No. [REDACTED] and was given on 10 January 1952. The lifeboats were 7 meters long, and the work boats 3.10 meters. The quality of the lifeboats, hitherto delivered, was termed very poor at a meeting of the VVM managers held on 11 March 1952.
