[REDACTED] fewer units are presently stationed at the Doellersheim training grounds than during last summer. Since the troops live strictly isolated, no difficulties with the local population have occurred; their discipline is good. The castle at Allentsteig had to be evacuated in December 1951, and since then has been used as a Soviet troop billet. The castle at Schwarzenau is used by civilians who pay rent to the Doellersheim training ground administration.
