25X1 On 23 and 24 June 1952, 46 ground attack aircraft and 5 biplanes were  
25X1 counted on the dispersal areas in the northern and southern sections  
25X1 of Reinsdorf airfield. The EW quarters appeared to be occupied to  
25X1 capacity. \*

[redacted] Comment. [redacted] on 14 April 1952, Reins-  
dorf airfield was again occupied by the same ground attack regiment which  
was stationed there in the summer of 1951 prior to its transfer to Juster-

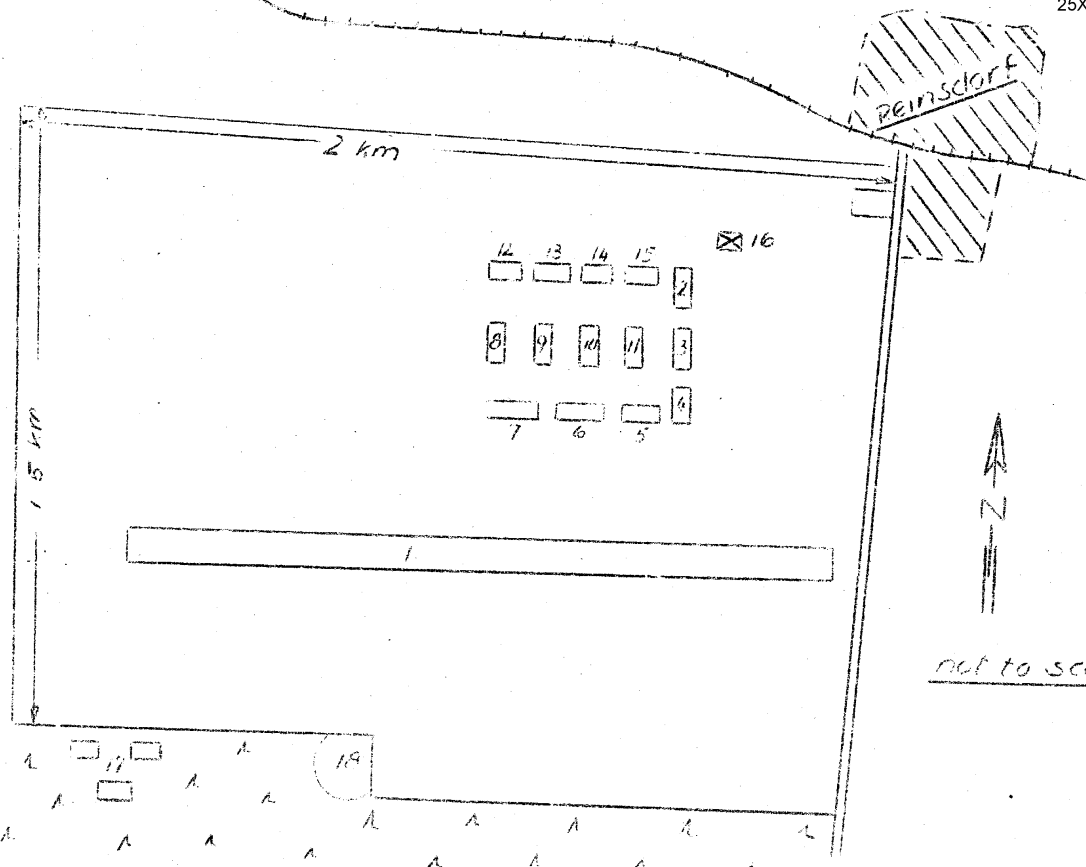
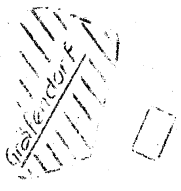
