- 25X1 1. Rather large scale conscriptions (estimated at 2,000 in Budapest) occurred on 22 and 23 July 1952 with the induction of the classes of 1932 - 34<sup>1</sup> reservists, and also certain specialists, including women.
- 25X1 2. Persistent reports of travelers state that the areas around Veszprém, Székesfehérvár, Hajmáskér, and Pécs are currently restricted, presumably because of Hungarian maneuvers. It is known that heavy gunfire has been heard in the vicinity of Balatonfűred, which may suggest that the maneuver area is overrunning some of the vacation spots around Lake Balaton.

25X1 [ ] Comment: The induction of the class of 1934 is not confirmed.
