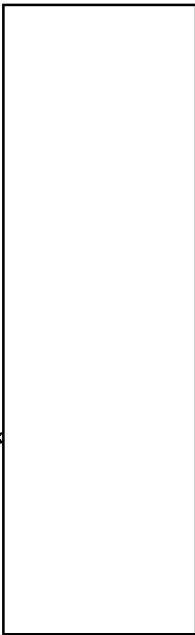

h. Between 7 and 9 July, [redacted] 100 boxcars were assembled at the Weimar freight station. (12)

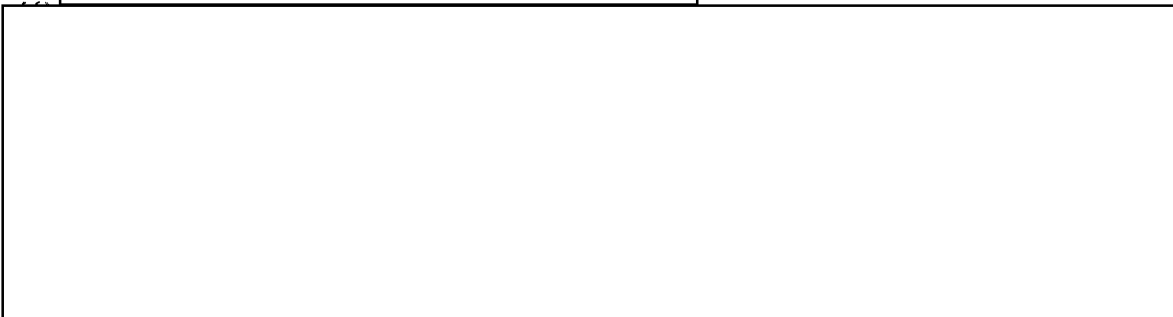
Comments.

(4) Possibly the return of elements of the 199th Light Arty Brig of the Third Gds Mecz Army which [redacted] went from Rehagen-Klausdorf to Altengrabow on 3 July. [redacted] It appears credible that the train was bound for Jueterbog as, [redacted] this artillery brigade has meanwhile been transferred from Rehagen-Klausdorf to Jueterbog.

(5) It is fairly definitely believed that, as on 16 July, an additional unit of the 31st AAA Div of the Second Gds Mecz Army returned from Wustrow [redacted]




