RETURN TO CIA LIBRARY

During the period from 21 to 30 June 1952, the Panzer Kaserne on Berliner Chaussee in Bad Freienwalde (N 53/V 28) was occupied only by a guard detail. On 29 June, 2 officers and 60 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets and carrying hand arms and baggage marched from the railroad station to the barracks installation. On 30 June, about 25 troops carrying hand arms and baggage went by rail from Bad Freienwalde to Eberswalde where they left the train. During the period from 21 to 30 June, no training activity and no heavy weapons were seen in the barracks installation. Motor vehicles [redacted] were seen shipping supply to and from the installation.\*

\* [redacted] Comment. The report confirms the Panzer Kaserne as being occupied by a guard detail of the units of the 6th Gds Mezz Div which are permanently stationed there. [redacted] It is believed that the guard detail was relieved in late June 1952.
