1. [Redacted] the National Army would soon be established in Eastern Germany. [Redacted] the combat efficiency of this army would be based on political indoctrination rather than on drill. [Redacted] the newly activated troops would have to attain the same extent of patriotic enthusiasm as prevails in the Soviet Army. [Redacted] it was planned, therefore, to reserve one third of the service time for political indoctrination.*

2. [Redacted] did not know of any plans for a blockade of West Berlin or for sealing off West Berlin from East Berlin. [Redacted] this would be inappropriate inasmuch as traffic with West Berlin encompassed several marked advantages for the East. [Redacted] political connections in Western Germany could be maintained by means of an interzonal passport prepared in Western Germany for West Berlin; and added that the Socialist achievements in East Berlin impressed the population in West Berlin and thus also the population in Western Germany. [Redacted] if a blockade of West Berlin were actually decided upon, the Russians would scarcely permit an air lift. [Redacted] the American guarantee for Berlin could not be taken seriously, as United States would not go to war because of Berlin; for a third World War would unavoidably result in the loss of Europe for the Americans.
