THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

1. A special meeting of the North Korean Labor Party (NKLP) of South Pyongan Province was held in the Mirim-ni district of P'yongyang on 5 and 6 June 1952. Thirty-two delegates from various counties in the province attended.
2. Most of the time of the meeting was consumed by the usual propaganda statements and repetition of policy themes issued by the headquarters of the NKLP, but some significant statements and directives on the following subjects were announced:
 - a. Military situation; The past two years has been a test period for United States military power, and the real war for liberation is just beginning. Americans have boasted they will advance to the 40th parallel, and therefore their military buildup must be watched.
 - b. Agriculture; If the rice is not transplanted immediately, there will be a poor harvest in the fall, so treat this program as a priority requirement. The NKLP Central Committee is greatly concerned over the rice harvest this year.

d. Security controls; A general roundup of all subversives and their families will be begun about 20 June in accordance with Cabinet Order No. 31. It will be the duty of party officials to cooperate with the MSS and the

police during this period, help them locate suspects, and report any discriminatory practices or acts showing sympathy for individuals on the part of the arresting authorities in the performance of their duties.
