- On 19 June Radio P'yongyang, operating on 20 kilowatts with a frequency of 820 kilocycles, was in underground shelters at Kirim-ni. The station was 300 meters northeast of the Karugye market and 200 meters northwest of the public playground. The station moved to the shelters on 22 March 1952. The Choson Recording Studio was 60 meters northeast of Radio P'yongyang.
- In late May 1952 a radio station built by the Japanese in Myongch'on-dong (125-44, 39-00) (YD-3720) and possibly used to relay broadcasts originating in China and the Soviet Union had not suffered any bomb damage. Four transmission poles were 10 meters to 12 meters high; the remaining six poles were 6 meters to 8 meters high.
- In June civilian mail in the P'yongyang area was being delivered once each day. Postage was 10 North Korean won.
- In June a bus available to civilians was running daily between Sinuiju and P'yongyang. The bus was departing from Karugye after sunset.
- By 22 June travel in and out of P'yongyang was not being restricted.
