- 1. Shortages of materials continue to hinder the progress of work at the Neptun shipyard, but six more drifters have been delivered to the Soviet Union. They were taken over at Stettin by Soviet personnel. Two more boiler installations for large freighters have been delivered by Buckau-Wolff.
 - 2. Of vessels undergoing repairs, REFRIGERATOR is 55 percent finished; SIGNAL, 62 percent; WENTA, 60 percent; FEOLENT, 48 percent. The KURA has made a trial run and is getting a new coat of paint. Repairs on the minesweeper RB 36 are 26 percent done; RB 49, 75 percent. Repairs have been completed on the guard boats MB 28, D 19 and D 18. B 8 is ready for delivery. More Soviet minesweepers and a 1,500 ton freighter have come in for general overhauling.
