25X1 identified or even confirmed were underlined in column 5 to make the information more

25X1 readable. The tabulation shows that the evaluation [redacted]

25X1 furnishes credible indications regarding the postwar location of 33 Soviet divisions

25X1 tional 17 divisions, i.e., 36 percent of the about 140 divisions believed to exist

25X1 in the U.S.S.R. The analysis of the assignments at the end of the war and the pre-
