- There is no aircraft factory in the township of Matyasfold itself, but the ٦. No. 1 Central Repair Workshop of the Hungarian Air Force (Honved Legierok 1 Számu Kőzponti Javitóműhelye) is located at Budapest-Mátyasföld airfield to the south of the town.
- Up to the beginning of 1949, the workshops of this unit were engaged almost exclusively in reconstruction of wrecked HAF aircraft. About 80 aircraft in all were reconditioned, including Bucker, Arado-96 and Focke Wulf planes.
- During 1950 and 1952 capacity of these workshops was appreciably increased by the importation of 17 or 18 machine tools of Russian make.
- Any rejor repairs, for which this workshop is considered inadequate, are undertakemby the Ikarus works nearby.
- Personnel at this shop include one airforce maintenance battalion (Repulesi 5. Kiszolgalo Zaszlowlj), which is mainly concerned with routing aircraft maintenance, and in addition two special maintenance companies composed of skilled workers.
