- : 80 tons of iron sheets, 50 tons of steel plates, 150 drums of wax, and 50 cases of radio supplies, on the SS T'UNG SHANG SSU (0681/0794/0934).
- : 75 tons of galvanized iron sheets, 5 tons of sulphur, 20 tons of crude rubber, 100 sets of tires, and 76 cases of radio supplies, on the SS NAN CH'IAN (0589/0734).
- : 20 tons of scrap iron, 40 tons of galvanized iron sheets, 20 tons of iron wire, on the SS SHENG LI; 4 tons of galvanized iron sheets and 35 tons of wax, on the SS HUA LI (5478/0448); 20 tons of galvanized iron sheets, 20 tons of 3/8-inch and 5/8-inch steel plates, and 20 tons of coal tar, on the SS PIAO CHI; 30 tons of scrap iron, 20 tons of galvanized iron sheets, and 40 tons of steel plates, on the SS TZU FU (5402/1381); 10 tons of steel plates on the SS LI HSIUNG; and 20 tons of galvanized iron sheets, 20 tons of iron rods, 20 tons of zinc plates, and 10 tons of tin plates, on the SS HSIN MING HSING.
