25X1 1. Six PE-2 planes were parked on the field adjacent to the aircraft repair shop on the northern outskirts of Wiener-Neustadt.

Observations made of Wiener-Neustadt airfield are shown in the attached sketch. The key to the sketch is as follows:

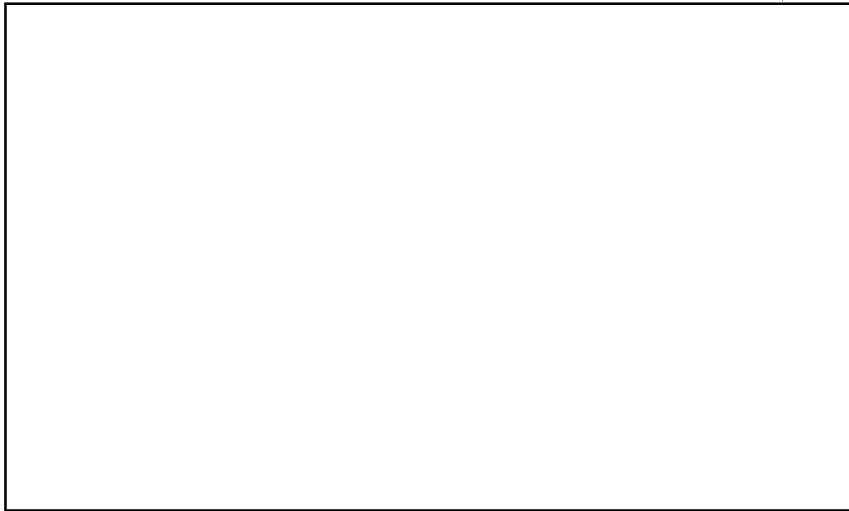
- a. fifty-five to sixty jet fighters parked in four groups with four, five, seven, and thirty-five to forty planes in each group
- b. main administration building
- c. repair shop
- d. three new, pointed, ten-foot pylons whose intended use could not be determined
- e. area where an undetermined number of revetments are under construction
- f. a twelve-foot high antenna mast, two wooden huts, and two peaked tents installed in the field approximately 550 yards to the east of Theresienfeld railroad station; no activity was observed here.

route of from fifteen to twenty trucks transporting gravel and stones from the aircraft repair shop area to area "e". Each truck was manned with from six to eight enlisted men. After unloading, the trucks and enlisted men returned to the aircraft repair shop area.
