1. The M/S TRANSYLVANIA, which has been in almost continuous use for the past two years in transporting [redacted] refugees from the port of Constanta [redacted] is no longer used on this route. It is believed [redacted] that the quota of 250,000 [redacted] refugees has been filled.
2. On 28 June 1952, the Rumanian ship passed [redacted] from Durres, Albania, to Constanta, Rumania. Since that date, the TRANSYLVANIA has not left the Black Sea. The ship reportedly is being used to transport Soviet troop replacements and Soviet civilians from Odessa, USSR, to Constanta.
3. It is believed that the TRANSYLVANIA had several high Soviet officials and specialists aboard on the last trip to Durres.
