- In September 1952, BfW (Beero fuer Wirtschaftsfragen) placed an order with Zeiss Jena for 160 gun sights (Peilaufsaetze) to be used by the Seepolizei. Production has already started. The sights contain several prisms which line up the target and water level (Libelle) of the gun.
- Zeiss produced sights for the wartime German Navy. They were used in coast artillery as range finders. This is the first postwar production.
- No submarine telescopes are being made at Zeiss.
