THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

- 1. A fortress called "Raduc" is located on the island of Murter on the height of the Raduc mountain. It is manned and occupied by 300 soldiers of the artillery. The fortress is armed with eight heavy caliber artillery pieces which are located in a cave.
- 2. On 16 July 1952 maneuvers were held and shots fired into the sea at stationary targets placed in the water at a distance of approximately 25 kilometers. The firing was heard to commence at 4:00 hours and end at 16:00 hours.
