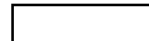
1. The average daily number of operational freight cars in the Russian zone of Germany between 25 and 30 September 1952 was 92,320. The average daily backlog of undispached cars was 2,750.
2. Between 3 and 10 October the average number of cars loaded was 25,534 cars per day. The average number loaded for the Soviet authorities was 1,546 cars per day.
3. Locomotives controlled by the SCC numbered 371, of which 118 were operating, 167 were held in reserve, and 86 were under repair, as of 15 September.
4. Coal stocks in the possession of the railroads on 30 September amounted to 12.3 days' supply. This included 127,755 tons of hard coal.
5. The daily average number of cars passing through the eastern border stations between 4 and 11 October was as follows:
