1. The Ministry of Interior representative in the Bitolj district, Macedonia, is Riste Novacev, who is from Graesnica in the same district.
2. There are two Communist Party cells in Velusina, Bitolj district, Macedonia. Prominent Communist Party members in Velusina are:
 - a. Marko Domazetov, political secretary of the community cells;
 - b. Trando Vojnovski, political secretary of the local cells;
 - c. Petar Apostolovski, chairman of the local kolkhoz;
 - d. Gligor Domazetov, custodian of the kolkhoz warehouse;
 - e. Risto Petrovic;
 - f. Atanas Temelkovski;
 - g. Efto Kocovski; and
 - h. Pandil Spatolovski.
3. In 1949 the Sloga Kolkhoz was established in Velusina and the peasants were forced to join it. Velusina has approximately 1,250 inhabitants of whom 700 are working members of the kolkhoz.
4. The kolkhoz has the following machinery:
 - a. two tractors (one new Fordson, and one German diesel Lantz);

5. In 1951 the workers were credited with 170 dinars per working day, but they were not paid.
