- 1. At the end of August 1952, the Bulgarian 3 Vidinski Infantry Regiment and 3 Artillery Regiment, both from Vidin, held maneuvers in the area of the villages of Vidbol, Vidin province, and Tsar Petrova, Kula province. Attached to 3 Artillery Regiment were eleven T-34 tanks from the tank battalion at Lom and an automatic rifle platoon. The regiment, to which the rifle platoon belongs is not known; however, after the maneuvers, it remained at Vidin.
- 2. Three high-ranking Soviet officers, two in civilian clothes and one in uniform, participated in the maneuvers.
