1. During the Leipzig Fair from 7 to 17 September 1952, the Carl Zeiss Jena, firm accumulated a total sale of 18 million DM East.
2. Sales orders for slightly more than two million DM East were concluded with Satellite countries. Of this amount, almost two million DM resulted from orders placed by Czechoslovakian representatives. The Czechs were mainly interested in optical measuring instruments - for example an unspecified quantity of Pulfrich photometers and 30 interferometers, and a large number of instruments for precision measurement. Czechoslovakia also purchased a planetarium.
