1. It was recently reported that three blocks of flats were being constructed for the use of Chinese sailors near the Dom Marynarza (Sailors' Home) in Gdynia. Only two houses were built in this area of Gdynia this year. One of them is a private villa, which is already occupied, while the other (a two-story building, still unfinished) will be a Sailors' Hotel, with accommodation for 80 men in communal dormitories. 50X1-HUM
2. The Dom Marynarza at Gdynia is exclusively reserved for and Chinese seamen. Polish seamen are accommodated in the Dom Marynarza at Nowy Port (Neufahrwasser), a suburb of Gdansk. 50X1-HUM
3. Since last summer the number of Chinese at Gdynia has decreased considerably as compared with the end of 1951 and beginning of 1952.
