- On 2 September 1952, two trucks loaded with ball bearings of various sizes arrived at the Sovrommetal Resita factory. The trucks belonged to the Soviet Army [REDACTED] 25X1B
- Trucks [REDACTED] are often seen in Resita. The drivers speak German with a Burzenland¹ accent. 25X1B
- The bearings came from Austria and were the product of the Styrrer factory, purchased through INTRAC in Vienna.
