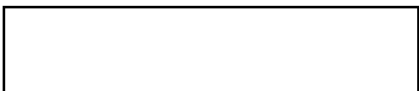

1. [Redacted] Comment. The report covers all loadings handled for the Soviets in the area of the Dresden regional railroad district in May 1952. Military supply traffic in this district dropped slightly, with 1,355 carloads in May as compared with 1,544 carloads in April. No unusual shipments were observed and supply traffic is considered normal.

2. [Redacted] Comment. The shipment of a carload of potatoes from Chemnitz to an unidentified AAA regiment, [Redacted] of the 6th Gds AAA Div (US) to Koenigsbrueck again confirms, the assumption that units of this division conducted firing practice at that troop training grounds during the summer. Elements of the division were confirmed there only by motor vehicle numbers identified in June and August. [Redacted]

3. [Redacted] Comment. At the end of April and in May 1952, engineer units of the First Gds Mezz Army were committed in Goerlitz. [Redacted] may have been confused with [Redacted] in Dresden several times and vaguely indicated its assignment to an engineer unit.

4. [Redacted] Comment. New airfields are under construction near Ganzlin (Betzow), Holthusen (Buchholz) and Gross Kudike (Schoenhauser-Damm). The shipments were presumably consigned to these building sites.
