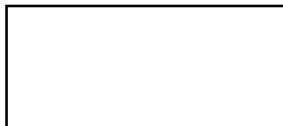

25X1 1. [Redacted] Comment. Possibly, at least some of the undetermined shipments were troop shipments.

25X1 2. [Redacted] Comment. This is the first report on Soviet military supply traffic in the Berlin railroad district. The information is incomplete as it does not include important supply centers like Jueterbog, Kammersdorf, Koenigswusterhausen and others. Nevertheless, it shows that, with regard to transportation, the Berlin railroad district is the most important. In June 1952 alone, the 11 railroad stations listed handled 2,282 carloads. For instance, the large fuel depot in Volten delivered 1,250 tons of gasoline in June.
